
Mandatory Guidelines to Students for Offline Examinations

1. Every student must report at the examination hall **15 minutes before** the commencement of the examination.
2. No student will be allowed to enter the examination hall 10 minutes after the commencement of examination.
3. Student must display the identity card without which he/she will not be allowed into the examination hall.
4. Students must carry their own stationery items such as pen, pencil, scale, eraser, ruler, calculator etc. Borrowing from others for the same during the examination shall not be allowed.
5. Bringing gadgets like mobiles, smart watches and smart calculators etc. into the examination hall is strictly prohibited.
6. Student must follow all the instructions given on the answer booklets and fill all the necessary details on the first page.
7. There should be no cross-communication among students.
8. Student is not allowed to take frequent breaks for visiting washrooms during the examination.
9. No student shall be allowed to re-enter the examination hall after leaving it unless he/she was under approved supervision during the full period of absence.
10. **No Student shall write their name anywhere in the answer script including on page No.1. If anyone writes that answer script shall not be evaluated.**
11. **Students are not permitted to write anything on the question paper.**
12. The student should stop writing answers when the scheduled time is over.
13. No student is allowed to go out from the examination hall half an hour before the end time of examination.

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14. All blank pages of the Answer Booklets or additional sheets should be stricken off.
15. The answers must be written legibly with a **Black or Blue** ink ballpoint pen only.
16. Every student should follow the instructions given from time to time by the invigilators, failing which severe action will be taken against the student.
17. Any kind of malpractice/irregularity/non-compliance of the above shall be referred to the "Committee on Examination Malpractices" for further decision. Until such time, the result of the student shall be withheld.
