

# ANNUAL REPORT & ANNUAL ACCOUNTS 2021 - 2022



Central University of Andhra Pradesh holds a special place in the Indian University System. It was born out of a promise made by Government of India to fulfill the aspirations of people of Andhra Pradesh on the eve of bifurcation of the erstwhile composite state of Andhra Pradesh into Telengana and Andhra Pradesh. The University is established in 2018 by an Act of Parliament in the district headquarter town of Anantapuramu in the Rayalaseema region of Andhra Pradesh with the Purpose of ushering a new era in sphere of higher education with innovative socially and culturally relevant academic programs.

The Govt. of Andhra Pradesh has allocated 491.30 Acres of land towards construction of its permanent campus. Buildings at Janthaluru (village). Bukkarayasamudram Mandal in Ananthapur District. The University undertook the preparation of Master Plan and the work has been allocated CPWD, Govt. of India and released an amount of Rs.105.00 Crores. For first phase of its project to start the construction activities. Due to enhanced academic and administrative activities the University hired CRIT Educational campus to provide more facilities viz., Class rooms, labs lecture halls, Library and hostels to the students,

The Central University of Andhra Pradesh started its academic programmes from its transit campus at JNTU Incubation Centre with 4UG AND 2PG programmes with total 119 student's intake under the mentorship of University of Hyderabad, Hyderabad. Consequent upon charge taken by Prof. S.A Kori as first &founder Vice Chancellor of University, the university added5 PG Programmes in the areas of Arts, Science &Technology which are industry relevant and job oriented programmes. At present the University is offering 4 UG and 7 PG Programmes with a total 413 student's on rolls for various programmes. From this academic year 2022-23 the University offers two new PG programmes in Molecular Biology and MBA in Travel& Tourism Management. The University is also planning to offer the diploma courses i.e., Diploma in Mobile Journalism, Diploma in Hindi Translation Studies and Diploma in Spoken English in accordance with the recommendations of NEP-2020.

The University has also signed an MoU with Ministry of Social justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India to establish the Dr. Ambedkar Centre of Excellence at University campus to start coaching to the Civil Service aspirants.

Presently, the University is running its academic programmes by hiring superannuated faculty, Guest Faculty, Distinguished Professors and filed experts drawn from the drawn from the relevant industry.

As a part of initiatives for implementation of NEP-2020, the University has revised its both UG & PG curriculum and all the academic programmes from the academic year 2021-2022 are embedded with discipline specific core and elective subjects, ability enhancement compulsory courses and skill and value – based course. Further the learner centric pedagogy is being adopted in the new curriculum and implemented from the academic year 2021-22.
