As per the mandatory requirement, III semester students of B. Voc RMIT & III B.Sc (Hons) Economics students shall complete the lab component for Web Technologies and MS-office respectively. In this regard offline laboratory classes are arranged at CUAP transit campus Anantapuramu from 8th February to 13th February 2021 and followed by practical examination. Hence students are advised to attend the lab classes without fail. Those students unable to attend, such students of III semester results are withheld, however an oppurtunity will be provided during subsequent semester. Further, for those who report on 7th February 2021 their accomodation (except food) at free of cost is provided in CUAP hostels.

In addition, Students are advised to strictly adhere to the MHA (Govt. of India) Covid-19 guidelines.

- All the students should bring the latest Covid-19 (Swab) test (Negative) report taken 48 hours before 8th, February 2021.
- Physical distance of at least 6 feet to be maintained as far as possible inside the campus.
- Use of face cover/mask is mandatory.
- Washing hands frequently with soap or sanitizer.
- Self monitoring of health and reporting any illness at the earliest.
- Spitting is strictly prohibited.
